As part of Gloucester Dance Festival we welcome you to our Urban Dance Competition held during the October half term school holidays for children and young adults aged 4-18 years. We aim to create a well organised and friendly event for our many talented young performers of Gloucestershire and the surrounding counties.

The Urban Dance street / hip hop competition for which we also recognise popping, locking, breaking, krump, house, dancehall, waacking & voguing is the one part of the Festival where you can shout, cheer and make as much noise as you like!

Dancers compete by age as their date of birth on September 1st in accordance with the academic school year. Juniors 10 years & under, Intermediates 14 years & under and Seniors 18 years & under. Sections will be split further by age for solos & duets depending on the number of entries received. Dancers pay £8.00 each to include all dance sections they wish to compete in solo/duet/trio/quartet and/or group. Costumes, music lyrics and dance moves performed should be appropriate for all age groups attending and should not include inappropriate language, swearing, sexual, or explicit movements.

Spectators: All spectators (adults & children) pay £8.00 to enter the performance hall. GDF operates a wristband system. Everyone, including competitors are required to wear their wristband on their wrist and show to the performance hall door stewards each time they enter.

Ribston Hall High School. We will only be using the side entrance for access to the competition available from the front car park across the grass area, or via the gated footpath from the rear car park. Wheelchair access is via the schools main front doors. Please advise the organiser. There is a large stage and ten allocated changing rooms. Dance schools entering groups will be given priority for their own meeting/changing room. A female only changing room will be allocated for individual female entries and a male only changing room will be available on the lower ground floor next to the boys toilets.

Entries will only be accepted if completed on the GDF official entry forms

Payment must be made in full at time of entry via bacs, cheque, or cash.

Confirmation: All entries will be sent an electronic receipt and confirmation of entry.
